Highlights and struggles of our ministry over the past year:

Despite the ongoing needs and opportunities for evangelical teaching in Poland, I became less convinced that outsiders are needed to meet them. The evangelical community in Poland has been in existence for many years and has most of the resources needed. Many students I taught over our 15 years in the country are now pastors, teachers, and missionaries. While we can always be helpful, there comes a time when one must face squarely the question, “Am I making the best use of resources staying?” Those resources include considerable funding to keep a western missionary on the field and also our own years of training and experience. We came to the conclusion that it was time to consider new ministry, completed our service in Poland, and now move to New Zealand, where I will coordinate WorldVenture’s new work in the South Pacific. The ministry aims to partner with other evangelicals to reach international students and new immigrants in Australia and New Zealand.

For Prayer:

- Please pray for our children – that they would grow in the knowledge and love of God as they acquire the qualifications they need to earn their keep later on.
- For guidance—we don’t know many details about the ministry we will be developing in New Zealand and Australia, who we will be working with, or how much of our time will be spent on coordinating and overseeing new missionaries and how much directly with students and immigrants.
