In addition to cultivating relationships, evangelism, and various church ministries, Ralph taught a 15 week course to better equip local believers to share the Gospel with their Muslim neighbors in an intelligent and culturally appropriate way. God also provided opportunities for counselling, mentoring and discipling. We praise the Lord for the 20+ people who took the Muslim outreach training course last year, the opportunity to mentor two gifted workers who are ministering to Muslims, and the Muslim couple that Ralph and Sandra were helping through marriage counselling who prayed to receive Jesus Christ as their Savior. During our time in the States, one of the men that Ralph was discipling saw his wife become a follower of Jesus.

For Prayer

- Although our vision is to share the Gospel, disciple, then send people to their home countries to spread God's love, it is hard to see them leave.
- We continue to battle various sicknesses which limits our ability to minister. Please pray for good health so God's work can move forward.
- The Asian fellowship ministry of our local church here has been very successful and continues to average 30-50 believers and seekers each meeting. We would like to replicate this for those from a more orthodox Sunni Muslim background in order to provide a contextualized and safe environment for seekers to "taste and see" that the Lord is good!
- Ministry among the unreached communities continues to be hard and slow, but we are seeing progress and are praying for a breakthrough. Thank you for your partnership—we praise God that SSBC is able to join with us in the blessings of taking part in the harvest among the world's least reached people. God bless you!

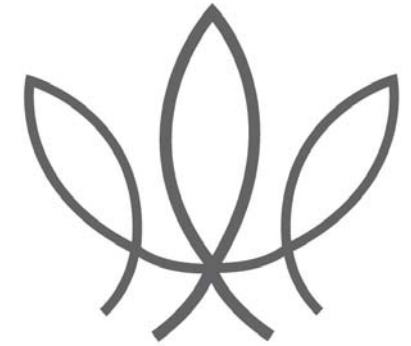
