Many people come and go. Although it is our vision to share the Gospel, disciple, then send people to their home countries to spread God's love, it is hard to see them leave. Also, many of them have heard the Truth, but have not come to accept the Lord as their Savior.

Health - We continue to battle various sicknesses. Often this limits our ability to function normal and carry out ministry. Please pray for good health so God's work can move forward.

The Asian fellowship ministry of our local church here has been successful and continues to average 30-50 believers and seekers each meeting. We hope to replicate this for those from a more orthodox Sunni Muslim background to provide a safe environment to "taste and see" that the Lord is good!

Ministry among the unreached communities continues to be hard and slow, but we see progress. Thank you for your partnership—we praise God that SSBC joins with us in the blessings of taking part in the harvest among the world's least reached people.

Highlights and struggles of our ministry over the past year:

In addition to cultivating relationships, evangelism, and various Church ministries, Ralph taught a 15 week course called "Building Bridges" in order to better equip local believers to share the Gospel with their Muslim neighbors in an intelligent and culturally appropriate way. God also provided opportunities for counselling, mentoring and discipling. We praise the Lord for the 20+ people who took the Muslim outreach training course last year, the opportunity to mentor two gifted workers who are ministering to Muslims, and the Muslim couple that Ralph and Sandra were helping through marriage counselling that prayed to receive Jesus Christ as their Savior. During our time in the States, one of the men that Ralph was discipling saw his wife become a follower of Jesus.
